Code of Conduct and Dress

Dress Code

All Polo tennis players are expected to dress appropriately when using the tennis courts. The following clothing is not permitted:

- Shirtless
- Bathing suits or sports bras
- Cut-off shorts or jeans
- Shoes not made for tennis/athletics

Conduct on the Court

All Polo tennis players are expected to be courteous to their fellow players at the club as well as our Key Ranch neighbors. The following behavior will not be permitted:

- Loud, foul, or offensive language
- Intentionally hitting balls over the fence
- Walking through another player's court during play

Conduct During Junior Lessons

Polo junior program participants are expected to be always courteous to their peers and coaches. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action including running laps, short "time outs", or extra ball pick-ups. Some of these behaviors include the following:

- Foul or offensive language including jokes
- Throwing or hitting balls at other players or coaches
- Making fun of other players
- "Launching" balls over the fence on purpose

The safety and well-being of our players is our highest priority. The following behaviors are considered dangerous and detrimental to the Polo junior program and may require more severe disciplinary action including suspension for the day from the lesson or expulsion from the Polo junior program permanently:

- Racket Throwing
- Incessant Cursing
- Taunting or harassing other players
- Inappropriate or violent physical contact
